DUI MANDATORY CRIMINAL PENALTIES

	<i>Mandatory Jail Time</i>	<i>Mandatory Fines</i>
<i>1st Offense</i>	48 hours up to 6 months Judge may substitute 100 hours of community service instead of 48 hours in jail.	\$750.00 minimum up to \$1,000.00 maximum
<i>2nd Offense</i>	5 days up to 1 year	\$1,250.00 minimum up to \$1,750.00 maximum
<i>3^d Offense</i>	90 days up to 1 year	\$1,750.00 minimum up to \$2,500.00 maximum
<i>4th and Subsequent Offense</i>	90 days up to 1 year	\$2,500.00

As of the July 1, 2011 amendments to the DUI statute, no conviction or diversion occurring before July 1, 2001, can be counted against you.

Work Release and House Arrest are available options after 48 hours in jail on a first, second, or third offense. Work Release and House Arrest are available options on a fourth or subsequent offense after 72 hours in jail.

Every DUI conviction requires an alcohol evaluation, and the Court will order the person to follow the recommendations.

In the event of a conviction, automobile insurance rates can double, triple or quadruple.

A conviction can result in termination of employment and may bar travel to foreign countries, such as Canada.
