DRIVERS LICENSE PENALTIES

*****REMEMBER! YOU MUST REQUEST A HEARING ON YOUR LICENSE WITHIN 14 DAYS*****

1st Offense	30 days suspended and not less than 6 months and no more than 12 months Interlock Device, depending on past driving record.	1 year suspended and 1 year restricted to only operating a vehicle equipped with an Interlock Ignition device. Reinstatement fee: \$100.00.	1 year suspended & 2 years interlock. Reinstatement fee: \$400.00.
2nd Offense	1 year suspended and 1 year restricted to only operating a vehicle equipped with an Interlock Ignition device. Reinstatement fee: \$200.00.	1 year suspended and 2 years restricted to only operating a vehicle equipped with an Interlock Ignition device. Reinstatement fee: \$200.00.	1 year suspended and 3 years restricted to only operating a vehicle equipped with an Interlock Ignition device. Reinstatement fee: \$600.00.
3rd Offense	1 year suspended and 2 years restricted to only operating a vehicle equipped with an Interlock Ignition device. Reinstatement fee: \$300.00.	1 year suspended and 3 years restricted to only operating a vehicle equipped with an Interlock Ignition device. Reinstatement fee: \$300.00.	1 year suspended and 4 years restricted to only operating a vehicle equipped with an Interlock Ignition device. Reinstatement fee: \$800.00.
4th Offense	1 year suspended and 3 years restricted to only operating a vehicle equipped with an Interlock Ignition device. Reinstatement fee: \$400.00.	1 year suspended and 4 years restricted to only operating a vehicle equipped with an Interlock Ignition device. Reinstatement fee: \$400.00.	1 year suspended and 5 years restricted to only operating a vehicle equipped with an Interlock Ignition device. Reinstatement fee: \$1000.00.
5th and Subsequent Offense.	1 year suspended and 10 years Interlock Ignition device.	1 year suspended and 10 years Interlock Ignition device.	1 year suspended and 10 years Interlock Ignition device.

As of July 1, 2011, any license suspension of 1 year or more for FAILING a breath, blood or urine test, may be reduced to 45 days of suspension followed by 320 days of Interlock Ignition device and a restricted license that allows driving to and from the following places: Work, school or an alcohol treatment program; and the ignition interlock provider for maintenance and downloading of data from the device.

Any license suspension of 1 year or more for REFUSING a chemical test, may be reduced to 90 days of suspension followed by 320 days of Interlock Ignition device and a restricted license that allows driving to and from the following places: Work, school or an alcohol treatment program; and the ignition interlock provider for maintenance and downloading of data from the device.

Also, if you have a commercial drivers license, and you get a DUI (even in your personal vehicle), your commercial drivers license may be suspended for 1 year on a first offense, and permanently revoked and a second or subsequent offense.
